Description of Volunteer Positions

Social Coordinator: this person is responsible for organizing the food and beverages for any home game post-match socials as well as seeing that it is all set-up by the time the game is over and that everything is cleaned up afterwards. In the past 1 person handled this work. Going forward this should really be handled by all the parents on a rotating basis with the Coordinator responsible for scheduling who is working at which game, etc.

Fundraising Coordinator: this person would be responsible for working with the girls to help find fundraising opportunities, help establish dates for the fundraising activities and to provide an adult voice behind the girls when they speak to potential fundraising activity sponsors, e.g. supermarket managers for bake sales, gas stations owners for car-washes, etc. In general this person would oversee the girls' fundraising work to make sure that they are organized properly and that adult supervision is available at any events.

Team Photographer: This doesn't have to be just one person. The person or persons need to be at all games (that's why having more than 1 is helpful so there's someone available) and be able to take action shots during the game as well as candid before and after, plus team photos.

Team Videographer: If there is someone with a video camera, too, that would be great and wouldn't be needed all the time!
